

Coopers Mill Cottage - Campsite Rules

Prebooking Only - Sorry, we are unable to accept camping groups without booking and payment in advance.

Organized groups - Group Leaders are responsible for their group behavior and actions. All groups or individuals who are behaving in a manner that may distress or offend others will be asked to leave the site immediately.

Parking - Parking is restricted to the designated area at the side of the cottage.

Tranquility – Enjoy the silence. Walkers, cyclists and horse riders enjoy the sounds of the forest too.

Rubbish, Hygiene & Conservation - Do not tip food or gray water/oil on the ground, stream or into toilets. Use the kitchen or store wash point. Please clean the wash point after use.

Leave no litter - take your rubbish home.
Take home any broken equipment.

Pitches - Leave space - don't pitch within 3m metres of others.

Dogs - Well behaved dogs (and their owners) are welcome on site (maximum of one per party), but please notify us at the time of booking and keep them on a lead at all times. An extra charge will be incurred for each dog. Please clear up their mess.

Fires - Do not use the sawn and chopped wood in the store for campfires. It is solely for the heating of the house.

A small campfire is permitted restricted to the single designated spot, barbecues are also permitted, provided they are raised off the ground and do not scorch earth.
